omewhere on the border between genius and maniac, aspiring director/filmmaker/puppeteer Germán Alonso works on an endless array of puppets and films in his studio — a rented-out hangar on a small Los Angeles-area airport. While attempting to make his debut feature film MEXMAN, German struggles with conspiring producers, an aging Hollywood actor and his own mental health issues as he struggles to bring the Mexican robo-superhero MEXMAN to the big screen! 




